



Register as a Sub

Are you substituting for someone this season? Register below for the sport by clicking the link for your sport.

What do I do when I get to the field/court? Before the game, check-in with the league supervisor to sign the waiver and pay the \$10 per game sub fee if you have not already done so online. This must be paid for each game you sub for.

Dress for success and wear a shirt that is the same/similar color of your teammates.

How does the substitute policy stuff work?

If your team doesn't have enough players for a full team, you may pick up a player from another team for the game as long as the opponent's captain approves.

Beginning in Summer 2016, teams can add non-rostered substitutes to their team if they are short players, using the following process:

---Before your game starts, the captain must tell the league supervisor that you have a non-rostered substitute. At that time, the substitute will provide his/her full name, e-mail address, and phone number. Grab a sub card out of the league box and put the above information on it to save time. The substitute will pay a game fee of \$10 in cash if they have not already done so online and sign the league waiver.

---The league supervisor will record the substitute's full name, e-mail address, and phone number on the League Substitute Form. He/She will give the game fee to the supervisor and make sure the substitute signs the waiver.

--Dress like you know what you are doing. Subs should that is the same/similar color as their teammates'. Don't wear another leagues shirt. Really, do we need to tell you this?

A sub is only allowed to pay the \$10 sub fee twice. If a substitute wishes to play more than twice during that season, he/she must pay the remaining league fee and will be considered a rostered player from that point onwards! For example, if the league fee is \$60 and the subs has paid two \$10 sub fees, the substitute needs

only to pay the remaining \$40. This can be done in cash at the field, online via credit card, by check or cash at the field before the next game they plan to play.

If a sub is not declared before the game and/or does not pay the game fee by halftime, or the 3rd inning, the substitute will be ejected and we will set the score of the team that the sub was on to ZERO and the game will continue without the sub or the game will be declared a forfeit. If it's softball/kickball, the team must take an out for the subs spot in the batting order, unless the team has a player on the bench to sub for the sub.

Confused Yet?

Substitutes cannot be used in the playoffs.

Substitutes, once paying the full league fee, may receive a team t-shirt if in stock. Special orders will not be made mid-season.
